Motion 1:

In addition to the legislative authority to prioritize and allocate resources for Ryan White Part A and B funds for the San Francisco EMA, the HIV Health Services Planning Council should be given the opportunity to make recommendations to the Department of Public Health on all funding priorities for HIV Health Services funds.

Motion 2:

Each Center of Excellence should develop a Consumer Advisory Board consisting of no fewer than 5 individuals and who represent the diversity of the clients served. The Consumer Advisory Board will work with the COE Coordinator in order to facilitate the inclusion of the consumer voice in the continuing goal of integrating COE services in a way that is consumer focused and consumer friendly.

Motion 3:

That there should be a written HIV/AIDS resource guide that can be distributed to consumers. The guide can also be on-line, but should be printed in order to be available to individuals without internet access.
